#### 視聴(再生)前の確認事項

●本製品に電源コード、LAN ケーブルが正しくつながっていることをご確認ください。 また、インターネットアクセスが可能なネットワークに接続されていることをご確認 ください。

#### 視聴(再生)端末の制限

- ●同時に視聴(再生)できる端末数には制限があります。また、本製品の録画、ダビング、 再生の状態によっては、端末で視聴(再生)できない場合があります。詳しくは【同時動 作について】(13ページ)をご確認ください。
- ●本製品では、地上デジタル/BS・110度 CS デジタルともに「データ放送」「双方 向通信サービス」「字幕」は非対応となります。

#### 外出先から視聴(再生)する場合のご注意

### おまかせ録画について

おまかせ録画とは、ジャンルやキーワード、チャンネルなどの条件を設定 し、条件に合った番組を自動で録画予約することです。

- おまかせ録画は、録画を保証するものではありません。確実に録画予約したい番組は、番組表から予約してください。
- おまかせ録画で録画予約できるのは2日先までです。
- ●おまかせ録画で自動登録する番組は、1日の録画時間の合計が12時間までです。※対象番組がすべて1時間の番組であれば、12番組を自動で予約します。
- ●おまかせ録画の自動登録は、電源オフ時におこないます。
- おまかせ録画に登録できる条件数は、21 件までです。

#### ー括録画について
